AUTHORITY

The event will be conducted under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motorsport Limited (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, these General Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or instructions that may be issued.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au The CAMS Permit Number is: 308/1708/03

PROMOTER

The Event will be promoted and organised by the Victorian Historic Racing Register Inc.

EVENT DESCRIPTION

The event shall be a multi club quarter mile sprint to be conducted at Heathcote Raceway, Barnadown Drive Knowsley (just off Mclvor Hwy 18km out of Heathcote, towards Bendigo.) The event will be held on Sunday 17th August 2008.

ENTRIES

Entries will open on Friday 20th June 2008 and close on Monday 11th August 2008. The entry fee will be \$90.00 incl. GST. Cheques and Money orders should be made payable to the VHRR Inc. **Entry Forms must be completed in full and accompanied by the entry fee and lodged with the Event Secretary, 14 Aberdeen Rd, Blackburn South VIC 3130.** All drivers must hold a L2S or superior CAMS licence and be a financial member of a club affiliated with CAMS in Victoria.

Preferred car numbers are to be requested on the entry forms. These will be allocated on a first come first served basis. The event will be limited to 100 starters. If more than 100 entries are received the Promoter will select the entries as they see fit. A refund of the entry fee may be allowed for entries withdrawn up to 8:00 p.m. on Thursday 14th August 2008 by notifying the Event Secretary. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason thereto, in accordance with the provisions of NCR 83. Notification of acceptance of entry will be forwarded to all competitors in the week prior to the event. This may include additional information.

COMPETITION

Official Timed Practice of one run will commence at 10.00am on the day of the event. Competition will commence at the conclusion of official practice and each competitor will have a minimum of three official runs.

SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering will commence at 8.30am on the day of the event. All vehicles must be scrutineered and passed for practice and competition prior to participation. The driver's and competitor's current CAMS licence, Vehicle Log Book (if issued), Certificate of Description (all log booked cars of the 5th category excluding Group S and Group N) and current Club Membership card must be produced at scrutineering/document check and on request.

DRIVERS' BRIEFING

A driver briefing will be held at 9:30 am, on the day of the event. Attendance is compulsory.

INSURANCE

Competitors are covered by Personal Accident Insurance and Public Risk Insurance will be provided by the Promoters in accordance with Appendix I of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

TIMING

Timing will be electronic to 1/100th of a second.

PROTESTS

Any Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

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ABANDONMENT

The Promoters, reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel the meeting in accordance with NCR 59 of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

ALCOHOL

The consumption of alcohol by drivers and crews is forbidden. Consumption of alcohol in the pit area, paddock or any other non public area is forbidden until the conclusion of the meeting.

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

SAFETY — DRIVERS

Drivers must wear:

- A Helmet which complies with AS 1698, or other standard listed in the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and be deemed by scrutineers of the event to be in a suitable condition for motor sport use.
- Non flammable clothing including cover from wrist to ankles to throat.
- Suitable footwear.
- Goggles or visors with lens other than glass (AS 1609-1981) in open cars.

SAFETY — CARS

Attention is drawn to Schedules A & B in the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

ALL CARS MUST BE FITTED WITH:

1. Seat belts complying with Schedule I of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
2. A fire extinguisher, securely filled which complies with AS 1841 (but not AS 1841.2) of at least 900 g capacity. The fitment of a CAMS approved "on board" system is an acceptable alternative.
3. Fitted with two separate fastening systems on any front opening panel.
4. A return mechanism on each throttle which will return the each throttle to the closed position.

GENERAL

1. Reconditioned tyres will not be permitted.
2. Tubeless tyres must be filled to the optimum rim only.
3. Only roll bars complying with Schedule J of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport are acceptable. Roll bars are recommended in speed events.
