SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

AUTHORITY: The event will be a multi club hill climb and driver familiarisation day conducted under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, and any further regulations or instructions which may be issued will be subject to CAMS Permit 307/0909/07

PROMOTER: The event will be promoted by the Victorian Historic Racing Register Inc. C/O 380 Army Road, Pakenham, Victoria, 3810.

VENUE: The event will be held at Gippsland Park, Latrobe Road, Morwell, Victoria over a distance of 688 metres in a clockwise direction.

INSURANCE: The promoters have organised Public Risk Insurance to the requirements of Appendix I of the CAMS Manual.

ENTRIES:

Open:	August 1st 2007
Close:	September 9 th 2007
Fee:	\$80 per entrant Multiple entries will be accepted at \$30 for the 2nd and 3rd Drivers.

Entry forms must be completed in full and lodged, with fee, with the Event Secretary prior to the closing date. A maximum of 80 entries will be accepted in order of receipt. The promoter reserves the right to refuse entry in accordance with NCR83.

ELIGIBILITY: Entrants and drivers must be financial members of a car club affiliated with CAMS in Victoria and hold a current Level 2S Competition License or higher.

At scrutineering drivers will be called on to present a current club membership card, CAMS License, Competition Record (if issued) and CAMS Vehicle Logbook (if issued).

The Promoters reserve the right to accept or reject entries under NCR 83.

TIMING: The event will be electronically timed to one hundredth of a second. The Timekeeper is deemed Judge of Fact.

PROTESTS: Any protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII XII of the 2007 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport

ABANDONMENT: The Promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone, or cancel the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the 2007 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES:

During any competition, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the Drugs in Sport Policy conflict, the Drugs in Sport Policy will take precedence. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

AWARDS: A trophy will be awarded to the driver achieving the fastest time in each class in the speed classes, and for the fastest overall time of the event in the speed classes. A trophy will be awarded to the driver achieving the most consistent time in the Regularity class.

SAFETY: Drivers must wear: A helmet complying with a standard listed on Schedule D of the 2007 CAMS Manual and deemed by the scrutineers to be in a suitable condition for use in motor sport.

Non-flammable clothing covering from neck to ankle and wrist, in accordance with Schedule D of the 2007 CAMS Manual (Nylon type synthetic clothing is NOT acceptable).

Suitable Footwear to be worn, in accordance with Schedule D of the 2007 CAMS Manual. Thongs, sandals or shoes with open toes or high heels are not acceptable.

Goggles or a visor with lenses of a material other than glass to be used, in accordance with Schedule D of the 2007 CAMS Manual.

CARS MUST CONFORM TO: Section 6, Schedules A & B, of the 2007 CAMS Manual.

Including:	Seat belts
	Fire extinguisher
	Bonnet fastening
	Throttle return springs

All vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restriction requirements. Fuel must be "Commercial Fuel" as defined by Schedule G.

EVENTS: The Promoter envisages that the competition will be divided into the following classes: J, K, Lb, Sa, Sb, Sc, M, O, P, Q, R, Formula Libre, N, Marque Sports and Road Registered and Regularity.

Classes may be sub-divided or amalgamated at the discretion of the promoters.
