EVENT DESCRIPTION

The event shall be a multi club hill climb to be conducted at Rob Roy Hill climb, Clintons Road Christmas Hills [Melway 265 A9] over 670m in a single direction. The event will be held on Sunday 4th May 2008

ENTRIES

Entries will open on Monday 31st March 2008 and close on Sunday 4th May at 9:15a.m. The entry fee will be \$75.00 incl. GST. Cheques and Money orders should be made payable to the VHRR Inc. **Entry Forms must be completed in full and accompanied by the entry fee and lodged with the Event Secretary, 14 Aberdeen Rd, Blackburn South VIC 3130.**

All drivers must hold a L2S or superior CAMS licence and be a financial member of a club affiliated with CAMS in Victoria.

Preferred car numbers are to be requested on the entry forms. These will be allocated on a first come first served basis. The event will be limited to 100 starters. If more than 100 entries are received the Promoter will select the entries as they see fit. A refund of the entry fee may be allowed for entries withdrawn up to 8:00 p.m. on Thursday 1st May 2008 by notifying the Event Secretary. There will be no refunds given when applied for after that time.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason thereto, in accordance with the provisions of NCR 83.

Notification of acceptance of entry will be forwarded to all competitors in the week prior to the event. This will also include any additional necessary information.

COMPETITION

Official Timed Practice of one run will commence at 10.00am on the day of the event. Competition will commence at the conclusion of official practice and each competitor will have a minimum of three official runs.

SCRUTINY

Scrutineering will commence at 8.00am on the day of the event. All vehicles must be scrutineered and passed for practice and competition prior to participation. The driver's and competitor's current CAMS licence, Vehicle Log Book (if issued), Certificate of Description (all log booked cars of the 5th category excluding Group S and Group N) and current Club Membership card must be produced at scrutineering/document check and on request.

DRIVERS' BRIEFING

A driver briefing will be held at 9:30 am, on the day of the event. Attendance is compulsory.

INSURANCE

Competitors are covered by Personal Accident Insurance and Public Risk Insurance will be provided by the Promoters in accordance with Appendix I of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

TIMING

Timing will be electronic to 1/100th of a second. The timekeeper is deemed Judge of Fact.

PROTESTS

Any Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

ABANDONMENT

The Promoters, reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel the meeting in accordance with NCR 59 of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

ALCOHOL

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual.

In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.

SAFETY — DRIVERS

Drivers must wear:

- A Helmet which complies with AS 1698, or other standard listed in the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and be deemed by scrutineers of the event to be in a suitable condition for motor sport use.
- Non flammable clothing including cover from wrist to ankles to throat.
- Suitable footwear.
- Goggles or visors with lens other than glass (AS 1609-1981) in open cars.

SAFETY — CARS

Attention is drawn to Schedules A & B in the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

ALL CARS MUST BE FITTED WITH:

1. Seat belts complying with Schedule I of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
2. A fire extinguisher, securely fitted which complies with AS 1841 (but not AS 1841.2) of at least 900 g capacity. The fitment of a CAMS approved “on board” system is an acceptable alternative.
3. Two separate fastening systems on any front opening panel
4. A return mechanism on each throttle which will return the each throttle to the closed position.

GENERAL

1. Reconditioned tyres will not be permitted.
2. Tubeless tyres must be filled to the optimum rim only.
3. Fuel must be “Commercial Fuel” as defined in Schedule G of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
4. Only roll bars complying with Schedule J of the 2008 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport are acceptable. Roll bars are recommended in speed events.

NOISE

All competing ears must be fitted with a device that restricts the exhaust noise level to a maximum of 95dB(A) measured at a distance of 30 metres on a drive by test under full acceleration. Vehicles may be checked during practice and competition. Any competitors car that exceeds this limit will be warned.

A second offence will result in expulsion from the remainder of the meeting.

As Rob Roy is in an environmentally sensitive area and to ensure its future, it is in everyone’s interest to comply with this request.
