EVENT DESCRIPTION

The event will be a Multi-Club Hillclimb to be conducted at ROB ROY HILLCLIMB, Clintons Road, Christmas Hills, over a distance of 670 metres in a single direction on Sunday 25th November 2007.

ENTRIES

ENTRIES OPEN ON MONDAY 8th OCTOBER AND CLOSE ON TUESDAY 20th NOVEMBER 2007. THE ENTRY FEE IS \$80 (includes GST). CHEQUES AND MONEY ORDERS SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO 'THE MGCC VICTORIA ROB ROY ACCOUNT'.

Entry forms must be completed in full, accompanied by the entry fee and lodged with the Meeting Secretary **prior to the closing date**. A refund of the entry fee may be allowed for entries withdrawn at least five days prior to the event by notifying the Meeting Secretary. Entries withdrawn after this time will not receive a refund.

THERE WILL BE NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE.

The Promoters have arranged Public Risk Insurance to the requirements of Appendix I of the 2007 NCR. The Promoters reserve the right to stipulate the number of entries for this event, and accept entries in excess of such number at their absolute discretion. The maximum number of entries shall be 105, accepted in order of receipt. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason therefore - see NCR 83. If more than the maximum field of entries are received the Promoter will select entries as they see fit.

COMPETITION

There will be no official timed practice. However, an optional Familiarisation Run will commence at 9.30am on the day and competition will commence immediately afterwards. Each competitor will have a minimum of three official runs.

PERSONS ELIGIBLE

The event shall be open to members of invited clubs who are holders of a current CAMS Level 2S or higher licence. The invited clubs are those listed on the CAMS website as being currently affiliated with CAMS (refer – www.cams.com.au).

PARENTAL CONSENT

If any entrant or driver is under 18 years of age, the consent of his/her parent or guardian must appear on the entry form.

SCRUTINEERING

Scrutiny will commence at 7.30am on the day at Rob Roy. All cars must be scrutineered and passed for competition prior to participation. CAMS Licences, Vehicle Log Books (if issued), associated Certificate of Description (Category 5 cars only), and current Club Membership Cards must be produced at scrutineering and on request during the meeting.

DRIVERS BRIEFING

THE ATTENDANCE OF ALL DRIVERS IS COMPULSORY AT THE DRIVERS BRIEFING TO BE HELD AT 9.15am ON THE DAY. Drivers who fail to attend may be liable for a penalty imposed by the Stewards.

TIMING

Timing will be electronic, and be accurate to 1/100th of a second. Class winners will be those competitors with the fastest time for a single run in each class. In the event of a tie, the next fastest official time of each competitor will determine the class winner. Timekeepers will be considered Judges of Fact.

PROTESTS

Any protests must be lodged in accordance with part XII of the NCR.

ABANDONMENT

The Promoters reserve the right to abandon, postpone or cancel this event in accordance with NCR 59.

ALCOHOL

In accordance with NCR 145a and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, the consumption of alcohol by drivers and crews is forbidden. Consumption of alcohol in the pit, paddock and any other non-public area is forbidden until the conclusion of the meeting.

ENVIRONMENT

Rob Roy is located in an environmentally sensitive area, consequently all competitors must abide by certain requirements. No animals of any kind will be allowed on the site. Access to the property is from Clintons Road via Eltham-Yarra Glen Road (Melway reference Map 265 B9).

NOISE

All competing cars must be fitted with a device that restricts the exhaust noise level to a maximum of 95dB(A) measured at a distance of 30 metres on a drive by test under full acceleration. Vehicles may be checked during practice and competition on the day. *Any competitor's car that exceeds this limit will be warned. A second offence may result in expulsion from the remainder of the meeting.*

COMPETITION NUMBERS

Competitors permanent numbers will be accepted where possible. Please advise if this is the case.

SAFETY - DRIVER

Drivers must wear a helmet to a standard listed in the 2007 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and be deemed by the scrutineers of the event to be in a suitable condition for motor sport use, non flammable clothing, including cover from ankles to wrist to throat, suitable footwear, and goggles or visors with lens other than glass in open cars (see Section 6, Schedule D of the 2007 CAMS Manual).

SAFETY - CARS

The attention of competitors is drawn to Section 6 of the 2007 CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, in which all vehicle requirements are listed in detail. Vehicles must be fitted with a fire extinguisher complying with Section 6, Schedule H of the 2007 CAMS Manual. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual.

NOTE: Turbo/supercharged type cars within the Invited and Classic Classes will have the appropriate factor applied to determine class placement.

RADIO/TV TRANSMITTERS

Radio/television transmitters operating in the 2.4GHz band, eg. RaceCams, Telemetry, etc, must not be used, as this can cause interference with the finish line camera used by Race Control.

AWARDS

CLASS TROPHIES: First, second and third placings in each capacity class will receive trophies.

Outright FASTEST TIME OF THE DAY trophy will be awarded to the fastest historic vehicle. The outright hill record is open to any vehicle competing including the “shoot - out” event if held at the end of the day. This event consists of the fastest six cars on the day.

PERPETUAL TROPHIES will be awarded to the fastest in each category regardless of capacity or vehicle type.

The FASTEST FEMALE COMPETITOR will receive a trophy and her name engraved on the Diana Davison/Gaze Plate.

PROVISION OF ELIGIBLE CARS TO RETURN (WD) DOWN THE BITUMEN TRACK

Certain cars will be allowed to return to the pits, using the racing surface, at the conclusion of their individually timed runs. In most cases this will only be available to open wheel, rear engined, Formula Libre type racing cars who have minimal ground clearance.

All requests for this action must be made to the Meeting Secretary prior to the Drivers Briefing, and a decision by the Clerk of Course and formal announcement will be made at that time.

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

Notification of acceptance of entry will be forwarded to all entrants during the week prior to the event. This advice will also include any additional necessary information.

PLEASE NOTE: IT IS MANDATORY FOR ALL COMPETING CARS TO BE LOCATED IN THE PIT AREA. THERE ARE TO BE NO TENDER VEHICLES OR TRAILERS IN THIS AREA. Also, will please ensure that your vehicle is parked across the pit area, not facing down the hill for safety reasons.
