Peter Brock -Living with a Legend by Bev Brock

Fortunately, this book was given to me for Christmas as seeing it on display in a book shop I would not have made a purchase acting on the notion of knowing all about Brock as he is a contempory and been in the the media for years.

Well, how wrong you can be! Upon completion of the book I realised I did not know he at all essentially because the author, Peter's long term partner, using her skills as a teacher and councillor goes into her subject's philosophy and motivation in a most interesting way. The book is less about motorsport and more about the manner in which Peter handles success with grace and gratitude and life's losses with control, comeback and learning. In this biography both of the situations these situations come in abundance and on a reaching the final page you could be filled with admiration for both this champion driver as well as "Bevo". The story unfolds in an intriguing way and avoids being a date by date chronology although it can be a trifle repetitious. As you place the book back on the side-table, you are almost certain to compare your life with Peter's, feel inadequate in vision and motivation and understand how the man has earnt so much admiration, both here and overseas.
