We took the Quest FF1600 to the Easter Mallala races, to give the car a full shakedown.



We had highly experienced FF driver Jon Miles behind the wheel, with Grant Kelly and Damian Sykes on the spanners. It may not have been a great weekend on the track, but the knowledge and experience gained was excellent.

Following Mallala, Grant and Damian, along with other team members Connor Ryan and brothers Ross and Dean McLachlan, have done a full strip down of the car in preparation for a full engine and gearbox rebuild. The target was to see the car on the grid at the Winton FOS in August, with Grant Kelly at the wheel. But it has been decided by the boys, that to ensure the car is spot on when it does hit the track, that they will take a bit more time to get things the way they want. On this basis, they are now targeting a number of test days later in the year, and will look to see the car on the track at Sandown, historic Rob Roy and the Geelong Revival later in the year.

Team principal Chris Davison noted that "The boys want to set a really high benchmark when their car hits the track, so they are going to take a bit more time to get things right. Their dedication and work ethic has been fantastic, and I am really excited and proud to be part of their team. My role is to provide some opportunities for these young guys, and to then support their initiatives and efforts. There is no doubt that these young men have a lot to contribute to Australian motorsport in the future"

Formula Junior Group report.

In 2008 Formula Junior car owners celebrated the Golden Anniversary of their cars in events at Calder Raceway and Phillip Island where over 50 cars were entered for this special occasion that included overseas cars from Europe and New Zealand. Well it is about to happen again as a direct result of negotiations with Duncan Rabagliati in the UK, who has connections with Formula Junior organisations worldwide including Australia, and the topic of discussion is now the Diamond Jubilee worldwide events proposed for the forthcoming celebration period that will see cars being shipped around the world to participate in these important events that include those to be held in Australia.

The 3 Day Trial – 20-22 November 2015

Classic Road Trials Australia is pleased to introduce the "Three Day Trial": an exciting new event taking in some of Victoria's most spectacular roads and countryside, while enjoying friendly competition along the way. You will be challenged with a unique blend of navigational road trials and motorsport; Ideal for cars and drivers of all levels - you won't need a race prepared car or special race license. The event will be held from the 20th to the 22nd of November 2015 and entries will be limited to forty vehicles. Bring your pride and joy and a trusty co-driver to join us on what promises to be a highlight of the 2015 motoring calendar.

The event opens Friday morning with a "dial your own" (regularity) style ¼ mile sprint competition at Heathcote Park Raceway. After a sit down lunch competitors will spend the afternoon contesting for points in the first navigational road trail, arriving in Bright in the early evening.

Saturday will see entrants chasing trial points as they chart a path up the hills of the Alpine National Park to the beautiful Art Deco Golden Age Hotel in Ormeo for lunch. The afternoon will see a return to sea level, eventually arriving in Gippsland's lakes district.

The event culminates on Sunday with a hill climb and tarmac motorkhana at Haunted Hills circuit. After competition concludes in the mid to late afternoon the group will retire to a venue near Melbourne for a presentation dinner.

All road registered vehicles manufactured before 1989 are invited to participate; more modern sports & supercars may also participate subject to approval. Entries will be limited to forty vehicles.
