The book covers the early history of the Light Car Club and the beginnings of Rob Roy from 1936 to it's demise in 1961. Every meeting in pre-war period is covered. Including the cars of Peter Whitehead, Jack Day, Tim Joshua, Frank Kleinig and Arthur Wylie.

After the war covers the early years of Lex Davison, Arthur Wylie, Tony Gaze, Doug Whiteford and many others. Post 1950 to 1960 covers the exploits of Stan Jones, Davo, Bruce Walton, Bill Patterson driving Coopers. Many of the cars which started their racing history at Rob Roy include the Maybach, Wyliecar, Klienig Special, Whitehead's ERA, Walton JAP.

Every meeting is documented with a description from period reports, driver interviews, and each class result and overall results.

A historical account of every class and outright record is also documented. The text is supported with over 120 photographs.
